# **GAFS** Overview

## Global food insecurity at record high and continues to rise



Between **2016 and 2023**, the number of people facing a food crisis or worse conditions increased from **105 million to 281.6 million** 

FAO and WFP have identified

18 "hunger hotspots", including 22 countries or territories, that are expected to experience worsening food insecurity in late 2023-early 2024

GAFS brings together **60+ partners**, including governments, humanitarian, and development partners, to **exchange** information and coordinate global and country responses


# Global Food and Nutrition Security Dashboard: Getting the right data to the right people



presents forwardlooking research and analyses on food security and resilience


#### AgSupport

# Action: Comparing humanitarian and development funding for food security, agriculture, and nutrition side-by-side




Not so good: Same pipeline for every organization (underreporting).





# IATI FNS Financial Tracking & Methodology



#### IATI is the common language & foundation...







...to which domain-specific information can be added...





...to create rich, re-usable data for a wide range of uses
















#### Story so far

- There's no single code or classification for "food & nutrition security"
- We have attempted an initial broad search through a combination of sector codes, on the advice of the UN FAO
- Some keywords searches (eg "food insecurity" | "food security" - but lots of false positives)
- The IATI data returned has been integrated into the GAFS dashboard
- The results have been useful, but also mixed



## **Using IATI data: next steps**



#### **Next steps**

- The next step is to support publishers to "tag" their data with more precision
- This can help us find, track and use IATI data about specific responses made by donors and partners
- To do this we will:
  - Propose a new <tag> vocabulary in the IATI standard
  - Provide guidance on ways to annotate
     IATI data for Preparedness Plans
- Distinguishing between new, continued and repurposed funding will require further discussion

#### **Tag Vocabulary**

The Tag Vocabulary codelist defines external codelists which themselves provide codes and descriptions for tag elements.





# **FNS Contingency Financing Tracking Challenges**





- Persistent food and nutrition insecurity escalates, especially among vulnerable populations
  - Growing coalition demands timely responses to prevent dire outcomes.
- Fragmented international response system struggles amid rising crisis complexity.
- Global crises underscore weaknesses in international FNS response mechanisms
- Calls for updated approaches to systematize aid responses resurface
- Division of responsibility essential, but collaboration crucial for optimal outcomes.



**Sources**: IATI (via special code); internal reporting arrangements

**Objective**: Provide live / real time updates of FNS financing mobilized in response to an identified crisis

Value Add: Develops a previously non-existing framework for assessing the availability and use of contingency/emergency resources and modalities across the international ecosystem

**Limits**: Tracking these resources would require broad support and agreement from GAFS and other FNS partners
