## CONTEXT: STRATEGIC FOUNDATION

### Strategic Plan Operationalization

The Work Plan is anchored in the adaptive **IATI Strategic Plan (2026–2030)**, designed to deliver essential, high-value services aligned with partners' evolving needs and capacities.

### Budget and Resource Allocation

A **\$3.86 million budget** supports delivery of four strategic action areas, leveraging core and earmarked resources—including funding from the EU and BADEA—for maximum efficiency and targeted impact.

### Governance and Operational Systems

Robust governance and streamlined operational mechanisms are in place to uphold IATI's mandate, reinforce Secretariat accountability, and enable agile implementation.

### Country-Level Engagement and Results Orientation

The MVSP delivers catalytic support to partner country governments and local CSO networks through capacity-building, integration pilots, and policy engagement—ensuring measurable results and stronger country ownership.

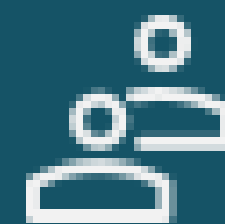

# At a glance: 2026 IATI Workplan and Budget

## Action Area A

- Tailored **support** for governments and CSO networks integrating IATI into national systems
- Country data use **mapping** to inform support services
- One regional **training workshop** + on-demand virtual support
- **Policy brief** on country integration lessons and bottlenecks
- 2–3 peer-learning **case studies** on real country data use

## Action Area B

- Maintain and **improve** Registry, Validator, Datastore, dPortal and unified backend
- Launch redesigned IATI **Dashboard** + four quarterly **State of the Data** reviews
- Targeted engagement with top **20%** of publishers on data quality
- Strengthened **Support Desk** with improved guidance and documentation

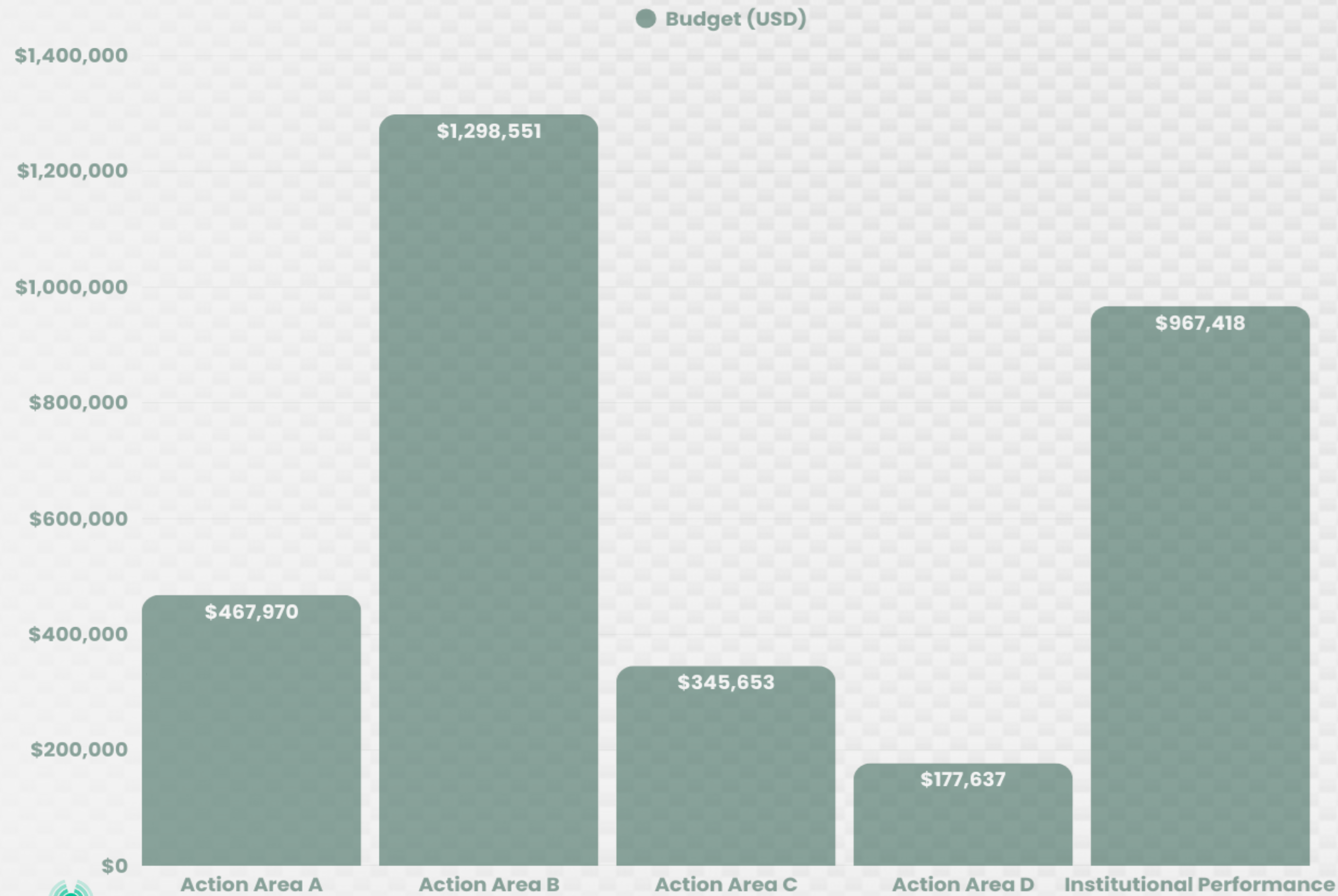
## Action Area C

- Participation in **four** major global transparency/advocacy events
- Four flagship partnership/advocacy **publications** + ongoing comms delivery
- Launch Transparency **Advocates** Network + **Philanthropy** Sector Forum
- Implement **philanthropy**/ high-net-worth fundraising strategy

## Action Area D

- At least three national/subnational **dialogues** using IATI data (VNRs, INFF, GPEDC)
- Two new **research partnerships** with universities or policy institutes
- Representation across global **policy processes** (FfD4 SPA, OECD/TOSSD, UNCTAD)
- 1–2 **insight briefs** showing IATI data's relevance to policy decisions
